Call for Tutorial Briefs

The IEEE Transactions on Circuits and Systems – II: Express Briefs (TCAS-II) is calling for proposals on tutorial contributions dealing with cutting-edge topics within the diverse fields of circuits and systems and the general scope of TCAS-II. These tutorial articles are expected to give a *brief overview* of a given topic and include a short background, a summary of the state of the art, trends and challenges, as well as potential application scenarios. Following the style of TCAS-II, these tutorial briefs should have a maximum length of 5 pages, although one or two additional pages might be allowed only for references.

Proposals must be submitted to the TCAS-II Editor-in-Chief Prof. Yajun Ha through email to: hayj@shanghaitech.edu.cn (authors are suggested to double check if acknowledgement has not been received after submission) and include the following information:

- Title of the tutorial brief
- Rationale and motivation, including an explanation of why the proposed research field covered in the tutorial is a hot topic within the interest of TCAS-II readers
- List of author(s) and affiliation(s), including a brief biography and a summary of the most relevant publications related to the proposed topic by the authors.

The proposals will be first evaluated by the TCAS-II editorial board and once they are accepted, authors will be invited to submit their complete briefs according to the schedule detailed below. Accepted proposals will follow a peer-review process similar to regular submissions and those papers accepted for publication will be published in the January Issue of TCAS-II in 2024.

Important Dates & Schedule

Submissions of proposals: 7 July 2023

Proposal acceptance notification: 21 July 2023

• Paper submission deadline: 1 September 2023

• Final decision: before 20 November 2023

Publication: January 2024
